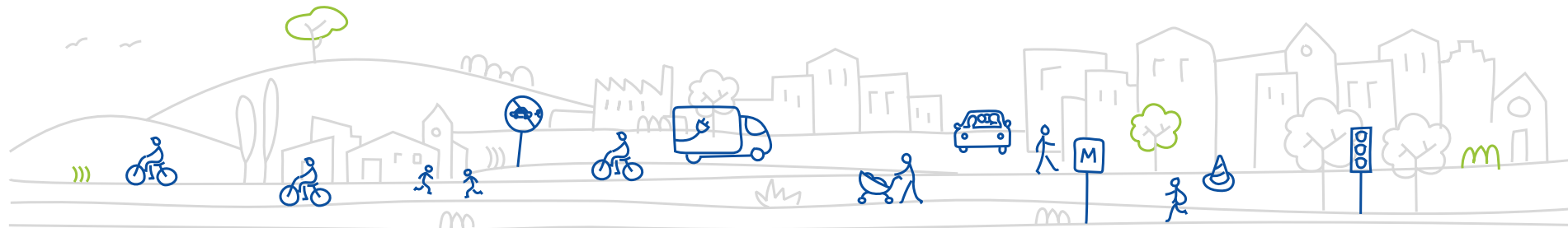

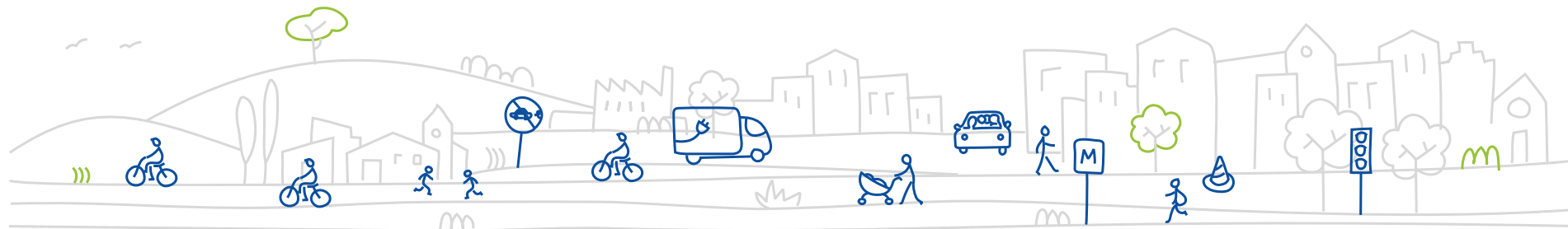

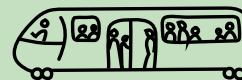

# CIVITAS Replication and Deployment Programme

## 12 Challenge cities



- Selected on the basis of their urban mobility challenges
- The Challenge cities will be matched in twinning pairs to work on their challenges
- Each Challenge city will host one site visit and travel to the site visit hosted by their twin city
- Each Challenge city will develop a deployment plan aimed at addressing their own challenge

## 24 Champion cities



- Selected on the basis of the best practices they would be capable and willing to share
- CIVITAS projects will be encouraged to have their cities engage in the programme as Champion cities to enhance their projects' exploitation plans and strategies
- Champion cities will contribute to the take-up and transfer activities with their best practices
- Each Champion city will join one site visit and participate in one co-creation workshop

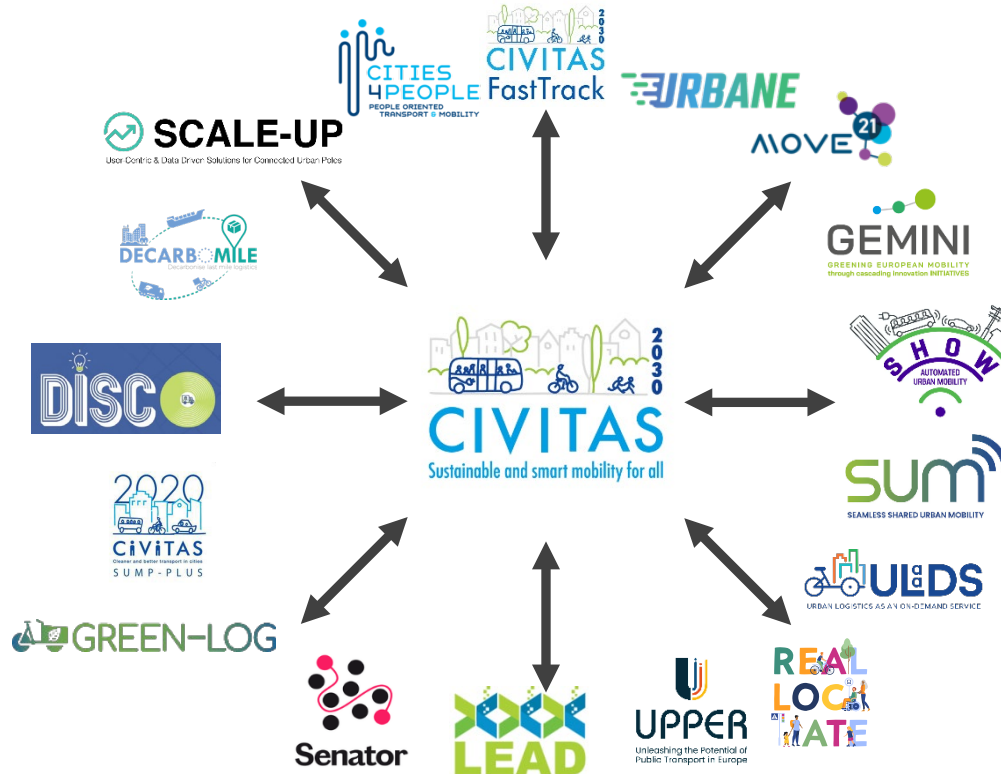
# Up to 5 Ad-hoc PGs

- The 5 **Ad-hoc PGs** will be selected upon the needs and requests from the CIVITAS community and DG MOVE
- Appointed on demand and focusing on specific themes for which there is a need to structure policy advice (selected, emerging, cutting-edge urban mobility topics), e.g.:
  - Zero-emission urban logistics
  - How can SUMP's better support urban nodes delivering in the TEN-T, etc.
- Each group will involve up to **5 experts** and will **meet once physically and online on a case by case basis.**
- **The ad-hoc Policy Groups will produce 1 policy paper each**

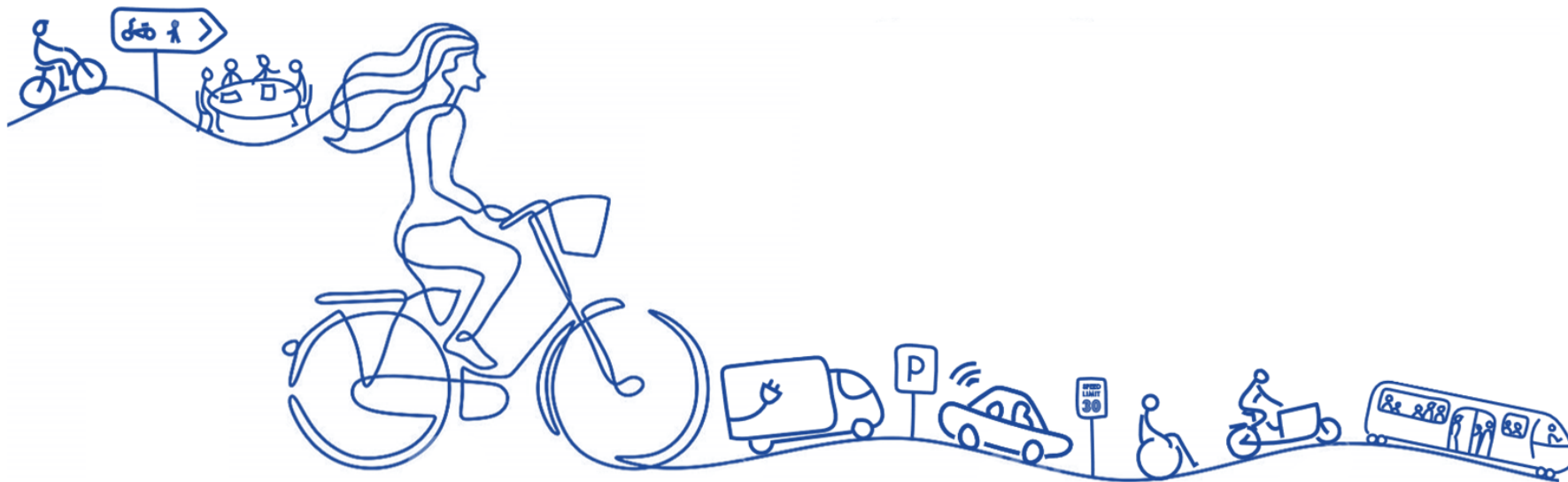
